Interfaith Memorial: We have been invited to an interfaith memorial .I guess we have all been sensitised to the horrors of religious violence and are praying in a way we have never prayed before and searching our own souls for any signs of racism.

Here is an invitation to a prayer service sent to me by a man I met at the Kilbirnie Mosque on the Friday after the Christchurch massacre. He is a Hindu and a member of the interfaith Committee.

"It is my pleasure to invite you and the members of your parish to St Peter's Church, 211 Willis Street, Wellington on Friday 12 April, 5 pm to 7 pm, Jallianwalla Bagh Massacre Centenary Remembrance Ceremony.

For Indians and the Indian diaspora, one of the worst massacres occurred on April 13, 1919 in Amritsar, when on the orders of one man, over a thousand peaceful protestors were killed by gunfire by the British soldiers. The incident has come to be known as the 'Jallianwala Bagh Massacre,' named after the Park where the massacre occurred."
